### Pitch Notification

#### **Why wasn't my solution selected? Will feedback be provided?**

Unfortunately, due to the volume of solution summaries received and the constraints on our resources we are unable to offer detailed feedback on individual proposals.

#### **I still haven't heard back about my solution summary. Why wasn't I notified of my selection status?**

Notifications have only been sent for submissions in topics 2-5. Notifications will be sent by mid-July for submissions in topics 1 and 6. You can refer to the [Sprint for Women's Health website](#) for updates on the timeline.

#### **I have been invited to pitch and have questions. Will they be answered in this FAQ?**

All pitch details will be shared directly with proposers via email. Please refer to your pitch invitation email for all relevant information. If you have any other questions related to the Sprint for Women's Health, you can submit them [here](#).

#### **Why can't I see my submission status in the BIDS platform?**

Only selections for topics 2-5 have been finalized. Selections for topics 1 and 6 will be finalized in July. Once selections for all topics have been finalized, selection status for topics 1 through 6 will be updated and visible in BIDS.

#### **Does the pitch deck need to exactly replicate the template sent by ARPA-H?**

All content from the template must be included in the final pitch. It is allowable to change the design/aesthetics.

### Solution Library

#### **I was invited to join the Solution Library. What is the Sprint for Women's Health Solution Library? How will the Solution Library be used?**

The Solution Library is a confidential repository of submissions with technical merit, accessible only to the federal government, and will allow for consideration for future funding opportunities. This recognition reflects the quality and potential of your organization's work. The solution summary you submitted will be kept in the Solution Library for up to 18 months for consideration for future ARPA-H funding opportunities. We may reach out about additional funding opportunities. The solution summary information will never be shared outside of this library without submitter permission.

### **Can I decline the invitation for my solution summary to be included in the Solution Library?**

### **Is it required to be an Investor Catalyst Hub spoke member to be included in the Sprint for Women's Health Solution Library?**

Yes, you must be an approved spoke to be included in the Solution Library. If you are not yet an approved spoke, please apply by Friday, June 28, 2024 at 12 p.m. ET.
