### Pitch Notification

#### **Why wasn't my solution selected? Will feedback be provided?**

Unfortunately, due to the volume of solution summaries received and the constraints on our resources we are unable to offer detailed feedback on individual proposals.

#### **I still haven't heard back about my solution summary. Why wasn't I notified of my selection status?**

Notifications have been sent for all submissions in topics 1-6. If you have not seen your notification email, please check to make sure it wasn't caught in your spam filter. All content from the template must be included in the final pitch. It is allowable to change the design/aesthetics. Please carefully review your pitch presentation before submitting to BIDS to ensure the presentation meets the guidelines outlined in the pitch template.

#### **Why can't I see my Solution Summary status in the BIDS platform?**

All submission statuses should now be visible in BIDS.

### Solution Library

#### **I was invited to join the Solution Library. What is the Sprint for Women's Health Solution Library? How will the Solution Library be used?**

The Solution Library is a confidential repository of submissions with technical merit, accessible only to the federal government, and will allow for consideration for future funding opportunities. This recognition reflects the quality and potential of your organization's work. The solution summary you submitted will be kept in the Solution Library for up to 18 months for consideration for future ARPA-H funding opportunities. We may reach out about additional funding

opportunities. The solution summary information will never be shared outside of this library without submitter permission.

### **Can I decline the invitation for my solution summary to be included in the Solution Library?**
